### **Haggai International Announces Sale of Mid-Pacific Center in Maui, Hawaii**

Maui, Hawaii — Haggai International, a global organization dedicated to equipping international leaders for transformative impact, announced on March 28, 2024, the successful completion of the sale of its Mid-Pacific Center property located in Maui, Hawaii. The sale marks a significant milestone in the organization's mission and reflects its commitment to responsible stewardship and strategic leadership.

The decision to sell the Mid-Pacific Center comes after prayerful deliberation by the Haggai International Board of Trustees. In light of the challenges posed by the global pandemic that began in March 2020 and the prolonged visa appointment delays affecting the organization's ability to utilize the center for its intended global purpose of equipping leaders, the board made the decision to explore alternative uses for the property.

Following discussions with local developers and community leaders, Haggai International ultimately entered into an agreement to sell the Mid-Pacific Center to the state of Hawaii for the development of much-needed workforce housing for teachers, medical personnel, and hospitality workers. The sale officially closed on Thursday, March 28, 2024.

"We're deeply grateful for the years of service and ministry at the Mid-Pacific Center," said Dr. Bev Williams, CEO of Haggai International. "Though we've never focused on bricks and mortar, bidding farewell to this physical space is bittersweet. With our in-person Haggai Leader Experience hosted in Asia over the last year, we have reached record numbers in participants and represented nations. Reinvesting proceeds from the sale into our mission excites us, given the momentum we are experiencing."

The Mid-Pacific Center has served as a hub for equipping global leaders for nearly three decades. Its impact has been felt far and wide, with over 12,000 leaders equipped within its walls in Maui, representing 117 nations.

In addition to its role in developing global leaders, the Mid-Pacific Center recently played an essential role in providing relief and support to the community of Maui in the aftermath of the devastating fires that swept through the island in August 2023. The center served as a haven for relief workers engaged in recovery efforts.

As Haggai International embarks on this new chapter, the organization remains committed to its mission of equipping leaders and transforming lives, communities, and nations through the Gospel of Jesus Christ. The proceeds from the sale of the Mid-Pacific Center will be reinvested into this mission, ensuring that the legacy of equipping leaders continues to thrive.

"We are grateful for the support and partnership of our global community and partners as we navigate this transition," added Dr. Bev Williams.

"Together, with hearts full of anticipation, let us press onward, knowing that our journey is guided by faith and fueled by an eternal purpose."
